So you're having a Neighborhood Garage Sale!

It is very kind of you to consider donating items that have not sold at your neighborhood sale to the Society of St. Vincent de Paul! We are able to accept gently used clothing and household items that are in good condition and suitable for resale in our stores.

Your sale coordinator has scheduled a time frame for one of our trucks to pick up donated sale remains in your area. Please notify him or her if you wish to participate. We have asked your coordinator to provide us with a full list of all homes that request a pick-up **at least 24 hours in advance**. Your driver will call the coordinator on the morning of the pickup to confirm this time frame, and to leave his direct cell number so he can be reached during the day if need be.

In order to ensure a smooth and successful pick-up, please observe the following protocols:

- **Please make sure that all smaller items are packed properly in boxes with flaps/lids fully closed, or in bags that are tied shut, to allow for proper packing in the truck.**
- **Please have the items packed and ready for pick-up, in the driveway by the time the truck arrives.** (We ask that items are placed far enough back on the driveway, away from the street, so that passersby don't feel welcome to rifle through them.) If items are not yet packed and ready for pickup, we would be happy to schedule a return trip at a later date.
- Please review our list of items that we are unable to accept. Our drivers will not be able to take any items from this list, or items that are not in suitable condition for resale in our stores.
- Due to the restrictions of serving a large number of homes in a short time, we are not able to collect furniture at this time. If you have larger items that you would like to donate, please call 278-2920 ext. 1 to schedule a pickup at a later date.
- **If it is raining at the time of your pickup, please keep your items protected (inside the garage, under a covered porch, etc.)** The drivers will not be able to accept items that are weather damaged.

Due to safety regulations, disposal & handling costs or limited resale value, we are unable to accept the following items:

- **Mattresses & box springs**
- **Televisions**
- **Sofa sleepers or reclining sofas**
- **Entertainment centers**
- **Hazardous chemicals**
- **Items that are prohibitively large and heavy that are difficult to safely handle (e.g. very large furniture pieces)**
- **Exercise equipment**
- **Large appliances**
- **Pianos, organs**
- **Futons**
- **Construction materials**

**If you are unable to have your sale remains properly packed and ready to be picked up by the time the drivers arrive, we would be more than happy to schedule a pickup for your donations for a later date.
